We invite submissions of 5,000 - 7,000 words (including footnotes). All articles will be submitted to a blind, peer-review process.

The *Loneragan Review* is a yearly journal of Lonergan Studies that invites submissions examining Lonergan’s relevance to areas within philosophy, theology, and religious studies as well as his relevance for the broader human, social, and empirical sciences.

All texts should be prepared for blind review by using double-spaced, 12 pt. Times New Roman font.
